Application

The portable radio is a main communication tool for ECRC, both in the field and within operational management. These radios are intrinsically safe and can be used in all environments. Response Centres maintain an inventory of radios that may be cascaded to any region and operated without having to be reprogrammed.

Description

The Motorola MOTOTRBO XPR 6580 IS digital portable radio operates in the UHF-800MHz frequency range. The radios have a number of operating channels to provide for greater flexibility when establishing a communication network with a lot of different teams. The radios can be used in a simplex mode (radio to radio) or through a repeater system. Dedicated transportation cases, meeting air transportation specifications, are available for the transportation of radios.
